

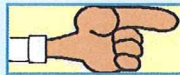

Today's Bible story is about

Moses



Some Pointers for Teachers~

- ⊕ **Plan ahead-**
Take time to review the lesson and make sure you have all the materials you need.
- ⊕ **Use your Bible-**
Children need to know that this lesson comes from God's Word. Even if you are telling the story in your own words have your Bible present.
- ⊕ **Make it FUN!**
The more fun you make this Bible story, the more powerful it will be! It's okay to be silly!
- ⊕ **Use Visuals-**
Some Bible stories can come alive by adding visual objects. Visual objects can aid in helping the children to remember the story.
- ⊕ **Relate to the Children-**
Show that you care about the children by learning their names and making eye contact when you speak to them. Try to involve all the children.
- ⊕ **Changing Voice Tone-**
When telling your story, sometimes use a whisper voice, other times don't be afraid to be loud! This can help keep the children's attention.
- ⊕ **Prepare yourself to ask age appropriate questions about the story-**
Give the children hints and make sure you thank them for trying to answer even if it's not quite the answer you were hoping for.
- ⊕ **Pray-**
Ask God to prepare your heart and the hearts of the children to receive the Lord's message. This may be the day that you are used to change the life of a child forever for Jesus!

About the lesson-

Why would we want to call Moses a super hero of the Bible? Primarily because Moses was known for doing what God told him to do even when the odds seemed to be difficult. It took a lot of faith to believe that God could open up the Red Sea so that he could lead the Israelites across it on dry land! Moses continually depended upon God for strength. Moses stood for what was right. The Bible tells us that he was the only one who came face to face with God.

Moses was not perfect He became angry on several occasions. He however was a great example of having "super" faith in God.

In today's lesson we will be focusing on Moses leading the Israelites to freedom as he miraculously crosses the Red Sea. **You can find this story in the Beginner's Bible page:**
